*Controlled yet expressive, this wine offers the characteristic exotic aromas of Gewurztraminer – rose petals, lychee and gingerbread.*
22. Conde de Valdemar Rioja Blanco Barrica 22.50  
Rioja, Spain  
*A successful blend of modern fruit and traditional oak ageing: lemony, smoke- and vanilla-scented.*
23. Sancerre, Domaine Cherrier 25.50  
Loire, France  
*Fresh citrus on the nose, with a palate of melon and stone fruit balanced with subtle grassy notes.*
24. Pouilly-Fuisse Clos Reyslié, Duboeuf 31.00  
Burgundy, France  
*This wine is vibrant and generous with apple and melon fruit, a creamy mid-palate texture.*
25. Vermentino di Bolgheri, Guado al Tasso 34.00  
Tuscany, Italy  
*This shows the combination of crispness and breadth that marks Vermentino, with engaging citrus flavours.*
26. Chablis 1er Cru Montmains, Brocard 38.50  
Burgundy, France  
*Delicious and well made showing a crisp, fresh fruit complexity and a smooth mineral texture.*

27. Kanu Rockwood 18.50  
Stellenbosch, South Africa  
*A nose of dark chocolate and raspberry, complemented by the peppery, nutmeg and cinnamon notes of the Shiraz component.*
28. Conde de Valdemar Rioja Crianza 19.75  
Rioja, Spain  
*Complex aromas of ripe black berries balanced with warm vanilla notes and a touch of subtle spice.*
29. Tormaresca NePriCa 21.00  
Puglia, Italy  
*Red fruits, black cherry and blackcurrant on the nose. On the palate, the spice of the Negroamaro is complemented by the juicy plum jam flavours of Primitivo.*
30. Château Terrefort-Lescalle 21.00  
Bordeaux, France  
*A medium-bodied, approachable claret with juicy berry fruit backed up by savoury tobacco notes.*
